The Greensboro Housing Coalition is at the forefront of collaborative efforts to advocate for healthy, fair, safe, and affordable homes in the greater Greensboro area. We take this responsibility seriously and strive to bring people and organizations together to address a variety of affordable housing issues.

In August of 2024, GHC hosted a Zoom meeting, bringing together key stakeholders in the affordable housing arena. One of the primary take-aways from the 2023 Housing Summit was the need for more collaboration and information sharing between non-profit organizations, government agencies, foundations, and concerned citizens. This meeting was the first of many to keep the lines of communication open and the ideas flowing in order to continue the important work of achieving affordable, safe, healthy, fair housing for all.

On October 10th, GHC hosted the 2024 Housing Summit with over 200 attendees. This year's summit entitled "Housing for the Ages", focused on affordable housing needs, types, and designs for ALL generations. Different housing challenges arise as we all go through different seasons in life, and GHC proudly facilitated this very important conversation.

Homeless and Rental Counseling and Support

GHC recognizes the urgent need for immediate intervention to address homelessness and rental challenges within our community. Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention

GHC understands that housing is not just about shelter; it's about creating environments that support physical and mental well-being. Our healthy homes initiatives focus on ensuring that housing is safe, free from hazards, and conducive to the overall health of residents.
