GHC Impact: Legacy Crossing Fire

After a fire started at a local apartment complex *Legacy Crossing*, over 15 people were forced out of their homes. GHC was able to bring a few of the individuals to our office and provide them with essential hygiene and clothing items, board games to keep their spirits up during such a tumultuous time.

The day following the fire, GHC coordinated with community partners such as Second Harvest Food Bank to hold a community resource fair for those affected by this tragedy at a local church. So far, two households displaced due to this fire have been provided Emergency Transfer Assistance through GHC's ETAP Program to relocate to a safe and healthy unit.

It is community collaboration like this that helps our residents to be resilient during times of hardship.
